SOME TIPS ON SAFETY FOR THE TOUR DE FOYLE 10:80

<u>RIDER</u>

Each cyclist should wear a suitable helmet, bright/ florescent top (cycling tops have useful pockets), padded shorts (for comfort), Padded gloves and light rain coat/wind breaker.

ON THE DAY

<u>Cycle:</u> Bring a bottle with water or energy drink if you prefer. Repair kit, tyre levers, spare tube and pump. Follow the rules of the road. On wide roads two cycles abreast, on narrow roads single file.

Run: Be mindful of the weather and bring appropriate clothing. Wear comfortable footwear and bring a bottle of water.

Water and light refreshments will be provided at the midway point for <u>both</u> events. Hot food and refreshments will also be served @ the finish line and are included in the registration fee.

BIKE

Get your bike serviced. Tyres/brakes should be in good order. Front and rear lights legally required for the Tour de Foyle 10:80 event. Your bike should have reflectors, a water carrier and a bell.

INSURANCE

The Tour de Foyle 10:80 events team provides insurance for the event. However, additional personal insurance is mandatory to participate. We have partnered with The Foyle Cycling Club and Cycle Ireland who will provide personal insurance for each participant. This is included in the registration fee. Cycle club members who have existing insurance do not need this cover and pay a reduced registration.

A team of event stewards, support vehicles and First Aiders will be positioned throughout both the 10k and 80k circuits.
